

8265 SHORT THROW WALL BOOM FITTING INSTRUCTIONS



1. **Establish the desired position of the interactive whiteboard**
2. **Headroom.** Consult the dimension chart in the projector instruction manual to establish whether there is sufficient headroom to mount the whiteboard in the desired position. Adjust position of board if necessary.
3. **Attaching the boom to the wall.**
4. Offer up the boom and mark the fixing holes on the wall. Ensure that the top flange of the boom is horizontal using the spirit level and fix the boom to the wall using **fixings not provided**.



5. **Attaching the projector to the boom.** Screw the swing arms to the projector using the m4 screws and washers provided.



6. Position the universal mount plate over the projector swing arms. Using the m5 screws and washers provided, fix the projector swing arms to the universal mount plate. The arrow points towards the wall when mounted.

- Offer the whole unit up to the boom and screw into place using the 3 bolts situated in the end of the boom.



Using a spirit level check the projector plate is level both (A) parallel to the wall and (B) parallel to the boom. Lightly tighten the securing bolts in place



- Consult the dimension chart in the projector instruction manual to establish the optimum distance between the front of the projector and the board. Slacken the two securing screws on top of the boom, slide the boom out to achieve the correct distance and lightly lock the screws in place. Recheck that steps 8 to 10 are still aligned



If a very large board is being mounted, it is possible to achieve extra throw distance by mounting the projector on the plate in the opposite direction, i.e. arrow pointing away from the wall.

- It is now possible to proceed with the board mounting in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Note:

Wall fixings are not included. Ensure wall fixings used are suitable for the task.

Maximum projector boom loading: 20kg

Ensure **both** screws on top of boom fix tightly against the inner slider when in use.
